**General Description:** Four booklets and four audio cassettes provide movement ideas, music, and stories for creative expression. Each accompanying music piece on the cassette is recorded two or three times for practice and/or performance purpose. "The Pompous Potatoes" features 18 short, choreographed pieces for ages four to eight. Lessons introduce concepts of space, level, size, pathway, and directions. As lessons progress, concepts are combined. Images deal with leaves, story ideas, paint, colours, wind, elves, and vegetables. "The Astronauts" features 15 choreographed lessons for ages five to nine. Lessons work with the concepts of space, direction, focus, level, pathways, and patterns. Suggested images include fairgrounds, spiders, games, astronauts, orchestras, colour, and winter. "A Fantasy Smorgasbord" features three stories with choreographed lessons for ages four to eight. "The Colour Goblins and The Golden Cradle" features two stories with choreographed lessons for ages four to eight.

**General Description:** Teacher and student activity cards, video, audio cassettes, music CDs, and a CD-ROM provide opportunities for movement. The teacher's material is organized into pink laminated key shapes that describe dance movements, exercises, and evaluation. Additional key-shaped cards provide activities and strategies for students to use in creating dances. Vocabulary cards, intended for student use, provide ideas for dance composition. The cassettes/CDs include selections of music to use with the movements or dance composition. The video demonstrates ideas presented on cards, and can also be used for student viewing. The CD-ROM can be used by the student to view various dance movements and to create choreography. The components are also available separately.

### **Music for Special Occasions**

**General Description:** Fifteen-minute video, part of the *Silver Burdett Ginn Music Magic* series, is appropriate for segmented viewing. Viewers discover that movement and music play a role in special events in most cultures. Examples of cultural/historical music and dance include the Nongak performers from Korea, the festivities of Carnaval, and a Kwanzaa celebration. The video focusses on the expressive elements of music which set the mood for particular movements. The resource can be used to introduce an awareness of different types of movement and to provide opportunities for vocabulary growth related to dance. The accompanying teacher's guide describes the episodes, and provides discussion aids, some critical thinking questions, suggestions for student follow-up, vocabulary, and additional information to aid in developing lesson plans.
