General Description: Two-level Australian series comprises a teacher's handbook, teacher's print resource package, student book for Stage B, and an audio cassette of songs and material from the student book. Content matches or exceeds expectations of the B.C. curriculum, but supplementation is required to meet the orthography outcomes. Uses an activity-based approach to language learning. It is suggested that Stage A be used in Grades 5 and 6 due to the level of difficulty. Stage B could be used with students in Grades 7 and 8, provided that these students had begun their study of Japanese in Grade 5. Two other levels of this series are also recommended: *Moshi Moshi* and *Pera Pera*. Please see the separate annotations for complete information.

Caution: *The song "Ten Little Indians" is on the audio cassette, and an activity sheet based on this song depicts a stereotypical view of First Nations people.*
