### Creating Music

**General Description:** Fifteen-minute video is part of the *Silver Burdett Ginn Music Magic* video series that explores topics such as rhythm, melody, voice, folk dance, and instrument families. In this video, viewers explore melodic contour and phrases. In episodes which are appropriate for segmented viewing students can follow a melody as a bell choir performs, see a computer-animated performance of a piece for synthesizer, and move to phrases while listening to a Hawaiian song. The accompanying teacher's guide describes the episodes, and provides discussion aids, some critical thinking questions, suggestions for student follow-up activities, vocabulary, and additional information to aid in developing lesson plans.
