General Description: Eighty-five-minute video uses the 1991 Toronto choir festival to emphasize the beauty of choral sound. It visits different cultures and historical periods through choral singing, architecture, and visual arts. World-renowned conductors and choirs perform many different styles of choral repertoire in rehearsal and performance settings. Children, youth, and adult choirs, both amateur and professional, are featured. Canadians profiled are: John Washburn of the Vancouver Chamber Choir, Jean Ashworth-Bartle of the Toronto Children's Chorus, Elmer Eisler of the Elmer Eisler Singers, and Patrick Wedd of the Tudor Singers. Teachers will need to isolate segments appropriate for individual classroom needs.

Music Ace

General Description: Software for Macintosh or Windows covers music fundamentals that include pitch recognition and discrimination; the relationship between written pitch and the piano keyboard; the treble, bass, and grand staves; octaves; half-steps; whole steps; and key signatures. It consists of three constructed learning environments: lessons, games, and music doodle pad. The accompanying user's guide provides installation and operating information as well as follow-up activities and assessment charts.
