## Adventures in Art Level 6

**Author(s):** *Chapman, Laura*

**General Description:** Multilevel sequential program combines studio activities, perceptual awareness, art appreciation, and art history. Level 6 comprises a student text, a teacher's edition, safety and technique posters, and a choice of visual support materials. The student book is thematically organized into four units: "Creative Expression," "Art Criticism," "Art History," and "Aesthetic Perception." Text is supported by large colour reproductions, questions for discussion, suggestions to address multiculturalism, and art vocabulary. The teacher's edition provides lesson preparations, teaching strategies, studio techniques, evaluations, and cross-curricular connections. The posters clearly illustrate for students proper methods and precautions for working with various art materials and media. The choices for visual support are large reproductions, overhead transparencies, or slides. Although there is not a Level 7 of this resource, Level 6 could be adapted for use in Grade 7 as well.

**General Description:** Sixteen-minute, four-segment video features British Columbia musicians, artists, and actors. Each segment in the video introduces career opportunities in the arts and emphasizes that anything is possible with commitment and hard work. The student hosts interview both adult and student performers/artists. The following segments demonstrate the usefulness of this resource for Music, Visual Arts, and Drama. They are numbered on the video as follows:
