1. You can catch a virus through the air.

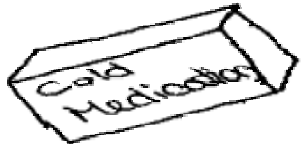


2. Always wash your hands after coughing or sneezing. Why you ask?
