DESCRIPTION OF THE PROVINCIAL EXAMINATION

The Table of Specifications outlines the curriculum organizers and the cognitive level emphases covered on the provincial examination. A detailed description of examinable material within each curriculum organizer will be found in the updated *Earth Science 11 and Geology 12 Integrated Resource Package*, 2006.

The provincial examination is divided into **two** parts:

PART A: **64 multiple-choice** questions worth approximately **70%** of the examination.

PART B: **9–11 written-response** questions worth approximately **30%** of the examination.

Please note: The **number** of written-response questions may vary from one examination to the next.

This examination is designed to be completed in **two hours**. *Students may, however, take up to 60 minutes of additional time to finish.*
