

BC Healthy Schools Network Timeline for Success

Introduction

The Healthy Schools Network Timeline is a quick reference for both new and continuing Network members to maintain positive momentum on school inquiry questions.

Setting action goals each month will help school teams achieve positive results.

October Phase 1: Build your Team

- Introduce staff, students, parents and partners to the Healthy Schools Network and the inquiry process
- Highlight the benefits to students of the Comprehensive School Health Approach
- Create your Healthy School Team and have your first team meeting
- Attend your fall NPBS/HSN regional meeting as a team

November Phase 1I: Assess

Phase 111: Prioritize

- Healthy School Team starts the school-wide assessment using an Assessment Tool
- Assess: Examine your school's strengths and areas for improvement
- Prioritize: Choose your area(s) of focus for improvement

December Phase 1V: Action

- Healthy School Team meets to plan for action
- Develop the school inquiry question
- Link your inquiry question to student learning using the Healthy Living Performance Standards
- Submit your inquiry question and assessment results

January Phase 1V: Action

- Decide on the evidence you need to collect to measure student learning related to the inquiry question
- Decide how you will collect the evidence and make it meaningful
- Link your school inquiry question to one or more aspects of the Healthy Living Performance Standards
- Attend your second NPBS/HSN regional meeting

February Phase 1V: Action

- Review formative assessment strategies in school teams or a staff meeting
- Talk about how teachers are using formative assessment in your school and the results they are getting with student learning
- Connect interested teachers to more formative assessment ideas and information

March Phase 1V: Action

- Collect samples of student work that demonstrate levels of learning on performance tasks used for assessment
- Consolidate your inquiry question evidence of student learning and improvement

April Phase V: Results

- Healthy School Team meets to plan for year-end Network activities
- Distribute Network responsibilities within the team
- Prepare your school story board display for your regional NPBS/HSN Celebration

May Phase V: Results

- Write your HSN School Case Study and submit it by the due date
- Share your inquiry results with staff, students and parents and interested educators
- Attend your regional NPBS/HSN Celebration with team members

June Celebrate and Reflect

- Celebrate your school's learning and successes gained through your Healthy Schools Network inquiry and use of formative assessment strategies
- Reflect on your learning and plan for September
- Receive your school's \$1000 grant for completing all the HSN requirements for the year
