CHOICES for Positive Youth Relationships

General Description:

This resource, consisting of a 20-minute documentary video called A Love That Kills and an instructional guide, is designed to address peer relationships among youth and to build awareness and understanding of the warning signs of abusive or violent interpersonal relationships. The video documents a true-life abusive relationship that ended violently. The comprehensive guide provides six lesson plans that support the video and deal with healthy relationship choices. Topics covered include identifying healthy/unhealthy relationships, warning signs, understanding behaviour choices and effective support strategies. The guide includes background information for teachers including curriculum links, teaching strategies, addressing diversity and tips if a student discloses. Lesson plans follow a consistent format and include all of the necessary materials. Additional information includes alternative and extension ideas, assessment tools and a generic list of community support resources. This resource is also recommended for Career and Personal Planning 10 to 12.

This resource is most suitable for classes of short time duration or minimum exposure hours.

Caution:

Some of the articles deal with sensitive subject matter, particularly in RELATIONSHIPS and HEALTHY AND WELL. In addition, some articles provide superficial coverage of the topic, and several topics in these two magazines may have more appeal for female students. Teachers will need to preview carefully and be selective in their use of articles, topics, and activities.
