Going Vegetarian: Adolescent Nutrition, Part I

General Description:

Sixteen-minute Australian video describes the basics of vegetarianism for teens. It explores reasons teens and others may choose to restrict their intake of animal foods and what food sources would give them an alternate source of protein. The video describes the relationship between the absorption of iron, vitamin C and calcium, as well as the negative effect of caffeine in iron absorption. It demonstrates the preparation of easy recipes for teens to acquire protein, iron, vitamin C and calcium. The video could be useful as an introduction to a unit on proteins, vegetarianism or legumes. It supports the need for materials on vegetarianism, and is also recommended for Food Studies 11 and 12.

Caution:

- Teachers should note the error on page 2 of the Teacher's notes that states "lacto-ova vegetarians also avoid eggs and milk products."
- Teachers will need to address the unsafe practice of two students dipping their fingers into a food dish at the same time, for tasting.
- Video may elicit strong debate about the consumption of animal products.
