TEACHING PROFESSION ACT REGULATIONS AND MINISTERIAL ORDERS

EXPLANATORY NOTES

A ministerial order is both a legal and administrative document authorized by statute to aid in the administration of the day to day operations of a ministry of the Crown. Frequently, the statute will give the minister the power to make orders, or rules or to enact another instrument, by using words such as "the minister may make orders" or "the minister shall make rules". Ministerial orders are assigned a "Ministerial Order" number (or "M" number), indexed, and filed in the Order in Council Administration Office in the Ministry of Attorney General.
