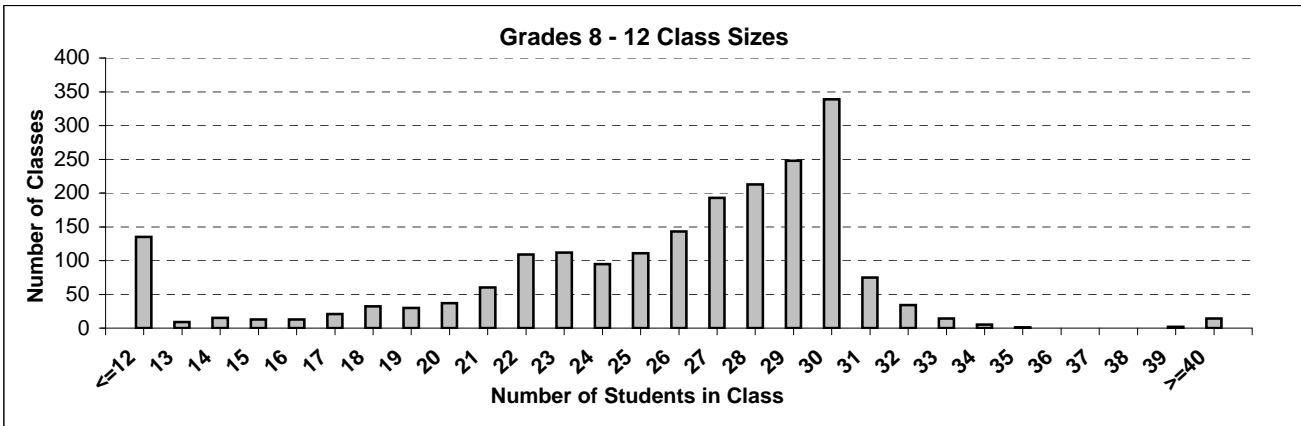
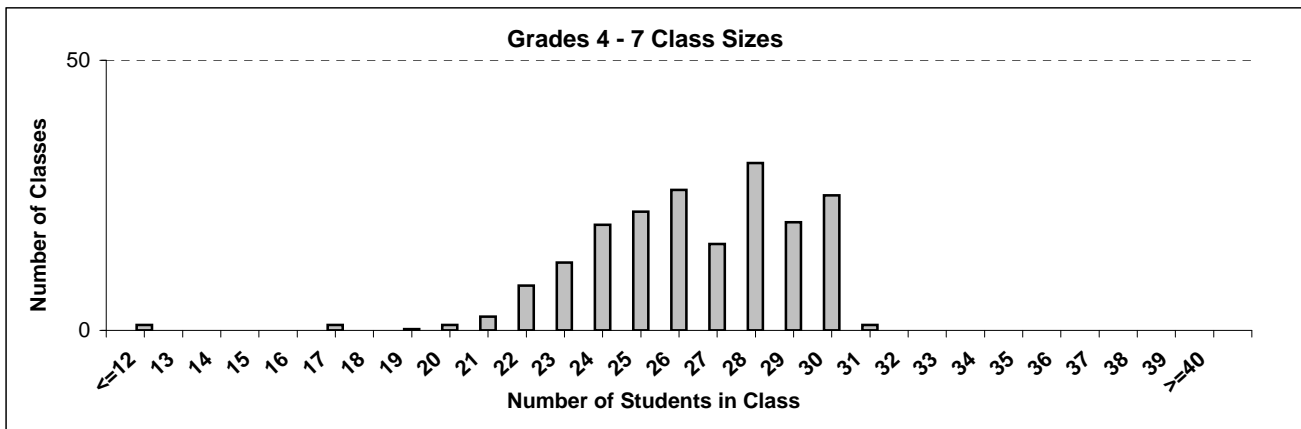
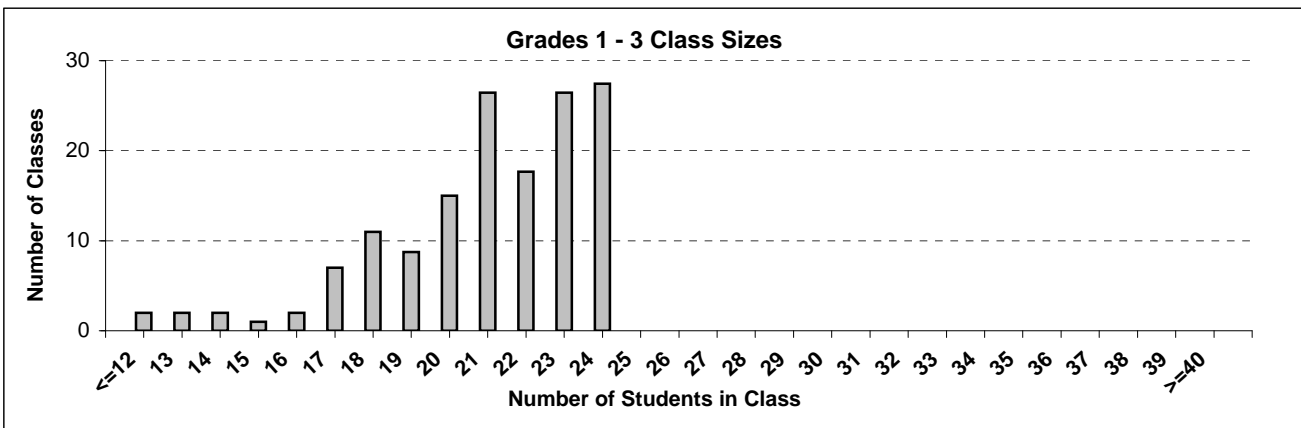

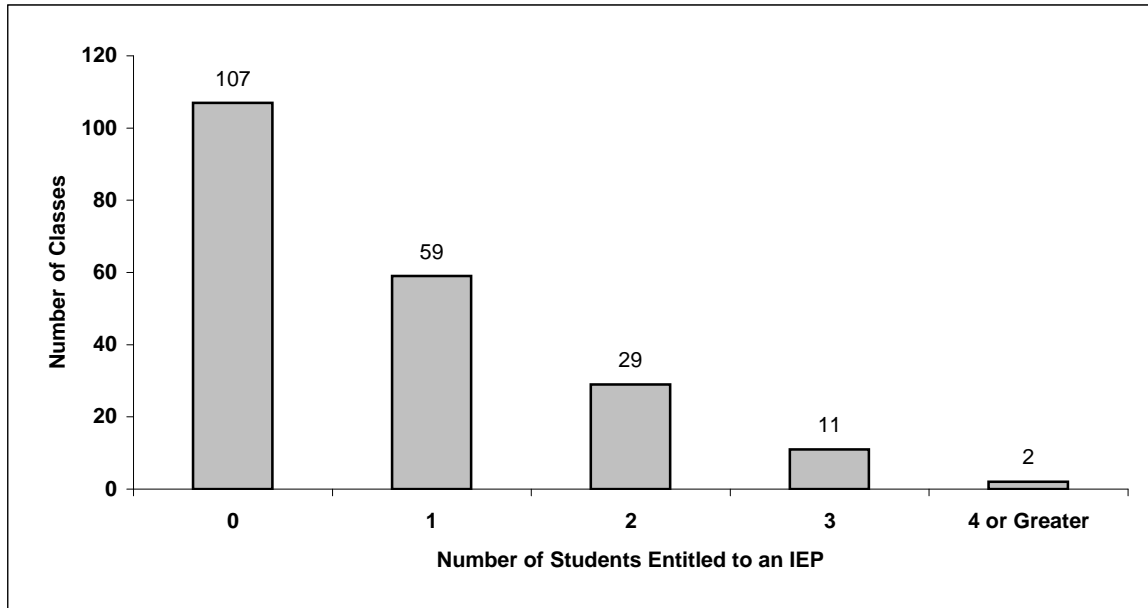

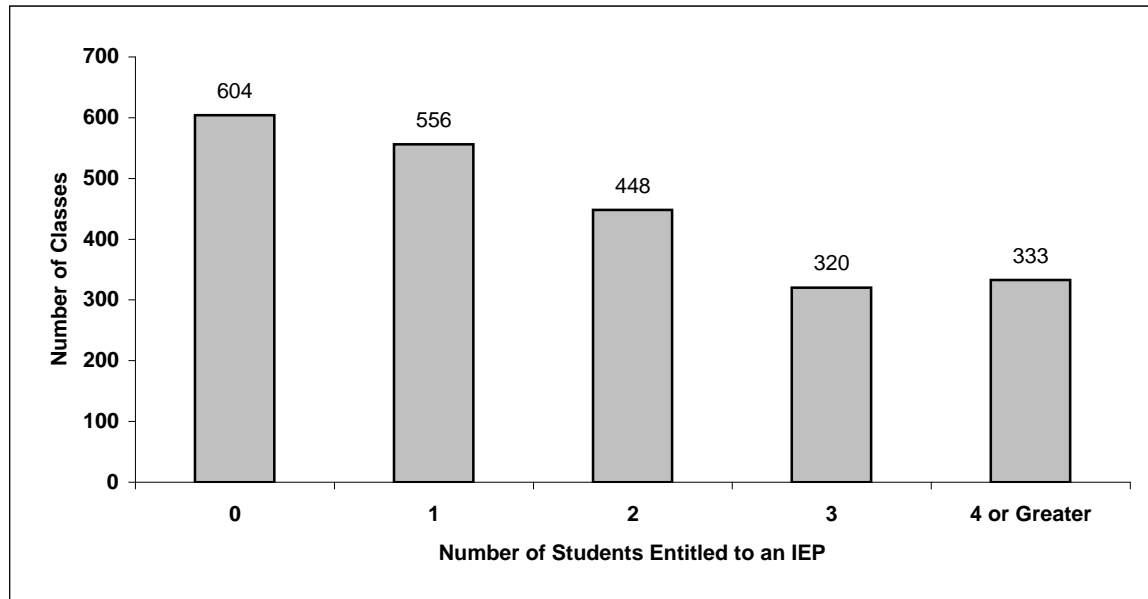

Grades 4-12 - Number of Classes in District with 'X' Number of Students Entitled to an IEP

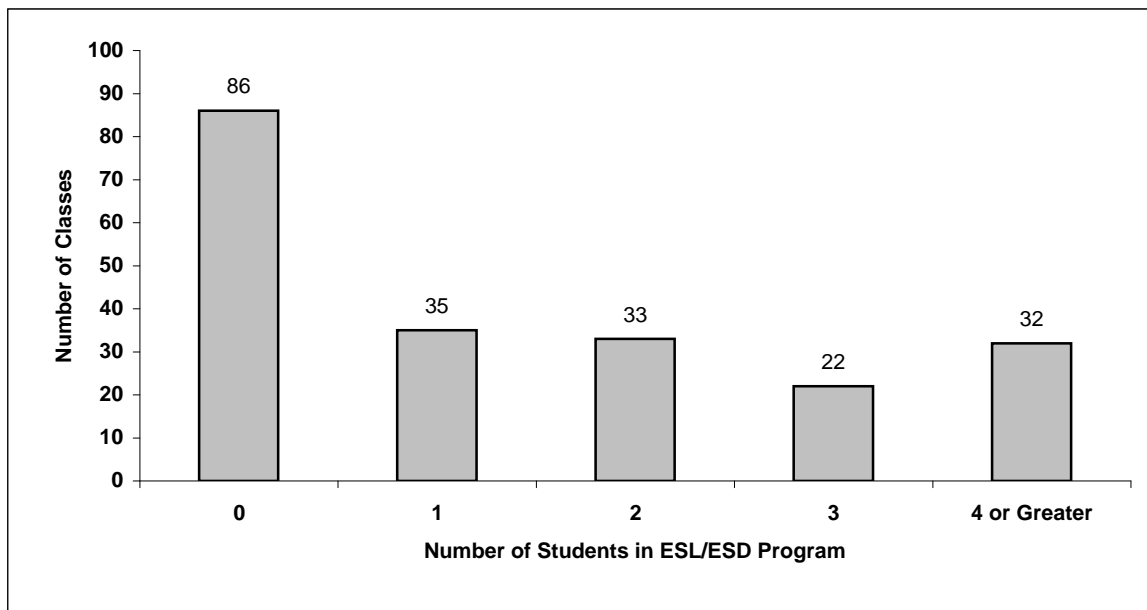


District - Students in English as a Second Language/Dialect (ESL/ESD) Program

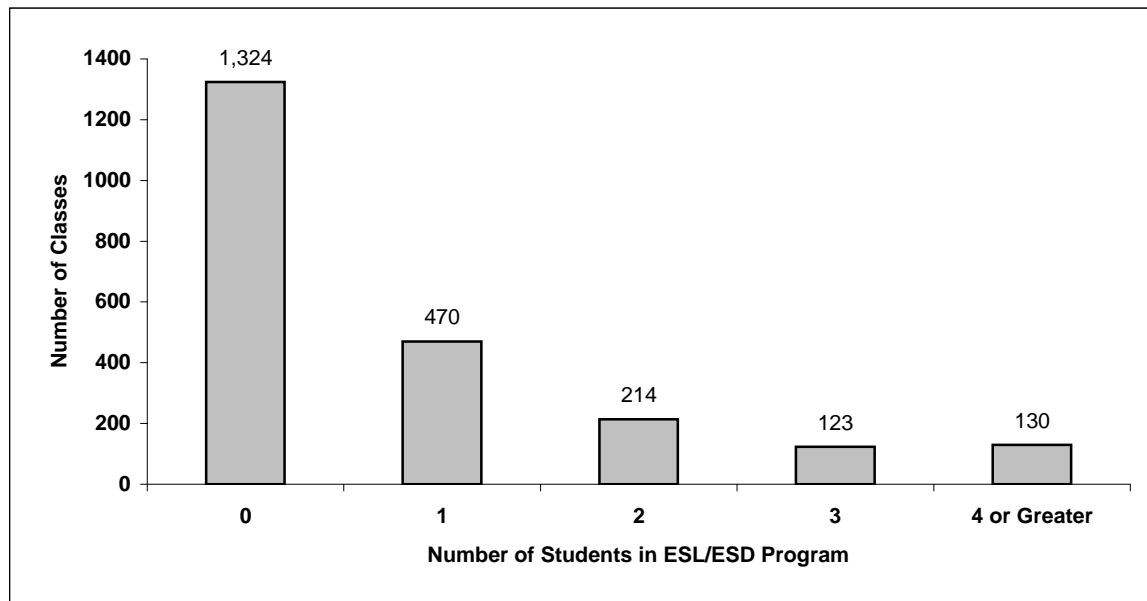
